



Role 3: Volunteer Photographer/Videographer

In this role you will be invited to photograph the Guildhall during visits and special events to create content that we can potentially share as part of our promotional material. You will use your photography experience to capture this historic building and give visitors an insight into the Guildhall's rich heritage.

Volunteer Photographer – Role Summary

We are looking for experienced and enthusiastic photographers to join our bank of volunteers and support us during seasonal and cultural events throughout the year. From shots of festive afternoon tea with Santa to atmospheric live music in the Great Hall, your photos will help to share the magic of St Mary's Guildhall far and wide.

What's Involved?

- Visiting St Mary's Guildhall to take photos, including during special events. If this includes members of the public, written consent must be obtained beforehand
- Uploading these photos to a suitable platform (such as wetransfer) and emailing them to us
- Giving permission for your photos to be used in promotional material (including social media, our website, flyers etc) You will be credited wherever possible

This role will suit you if you are...

- Experienced with photography, either in an amateur or professional capacity
- In possession of your own camera that you can confidently operate
- Keen to and have your work seen by a large audience
- Excited to spend more time in a beautiful medieval building

Additional Information

Timings: Flexible – you will be added to a bank of volunteers who will be contacted to provide photography support for specific events/occasions, with at least a week's notice. It would be very helpful if you can offer availability at weekends or in the evenings

Training: While previous photography experience is essential, you will receive additional guidance with GDPR and obtaining consent if members of the public are captured in photos. You should not take any photos of minors without express written permission

Expenses: Travel expenses will be covered up to a maximum of £10 per session. Volunteer benefits include free entry to the Guildhall, including for days that you are not volunteering

With over 700 years of history, the Guildhall is a stunning venue with interiors including the recently restored medieval kitchen and the majestic Great Hall. Following a 5.6 million refurbishment we are welcoming visitors daily for guided tours, as well as hosting both corporate and community events.
